“Why Free-hand Composite Dentistry will Rule in the Digital World”

Course Description:

This presentation will highlight and demonstrate traditional, and non-traditional, uses of direct composite for anterior and posterior restorations. Clinical photographs and videos will demonstrate the materials and techniques necessary to deliver life-like, invisible composite restorations. From Class V's to full composite veneers, the program will review the steps to create minimally invasive, beautiful direct resin restorations. Important considerations for peg lateral and canine substitution cases will be reviewed in detail. Finally, the course will conclude with strategies to manage severe erosion and wear patients to create optimal esthetics and function utilizing direct resin composite.
