Dr. Marty Zase – President-Elect/Treasurer

Dr. Marty Zase is the President-Elect/Treasurer of the New England Academy of Cosmetic Dentistry. He has also served as President of the NEACD from 2014-2018 and 2020-2022. Dr. Zase received his Bachelor of Arts from Boston University and his D.M.D. from Tufts University School of Dental Medicine. He has been a guest lecturer in cosmetic dentistry at the University of Connecticut, Nova Southeastern University, Tufts University, New York University, and Louisiana State University Dental Schools. He has published over sixty dental articles, has served on the editorial or review boards of numerous dental magazines, and has lectured internationally on cosmetic dentistry for over twenty-five years.

He has been granted fellowships in the American College of Dentists (FACD), the Pierre Fauchard Academy, and the International Academy of Dental Facial Esthetics (FADFE), and the AGD has twice awarded him the Lifetime Learning and Service Recognition Award for his contributions to dentistry and dental education.
